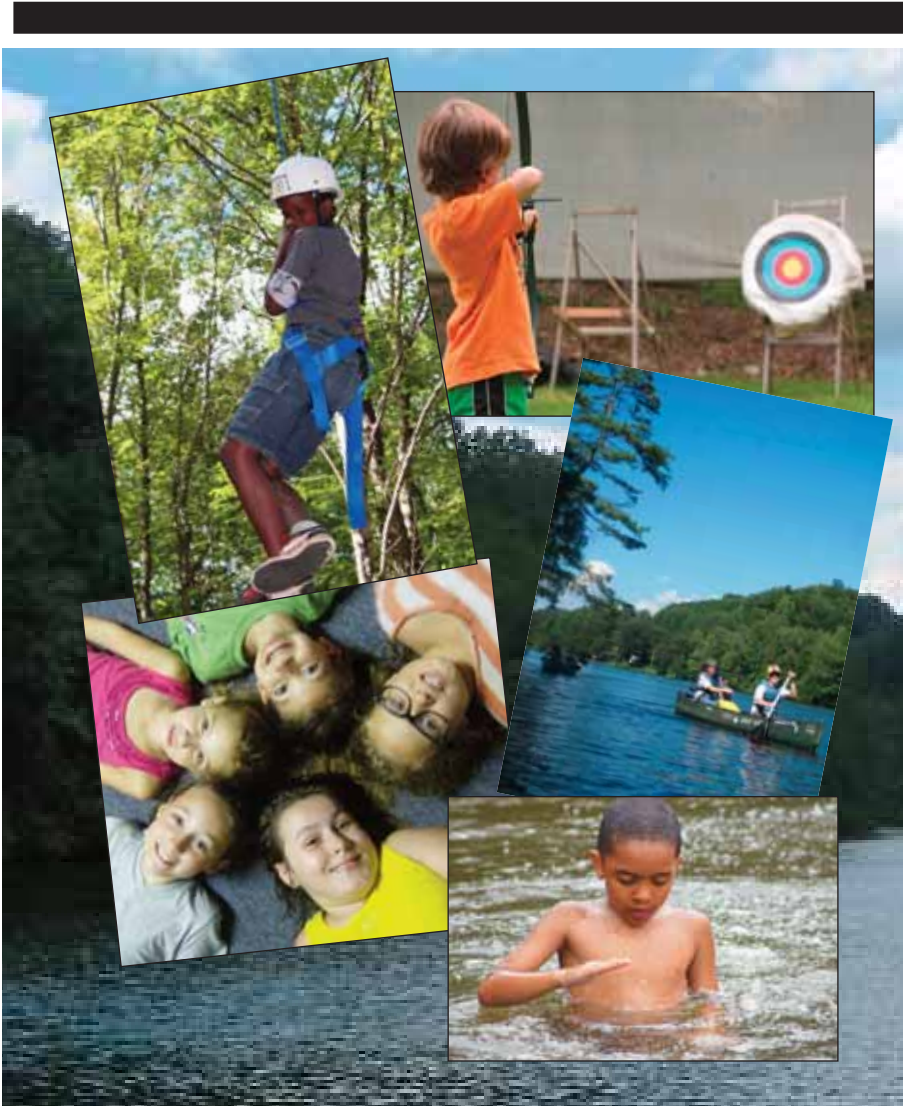
In addition our camp and staff are very active in the Presbyterian Church Camp and Conference Association (PCCCA).

Can I register more than one camper?

Use one registration form per camper. The registration form may be duplicated for each additional camper.

What is my deposit for?

Campers are registered on a first come-first serve basis, so register as early as possible. Your **\$75 deposit** is required to reserve your position in a camp. **The balance of the camp fee is due 2 weeks before your session.**

Are there any discounts available?

(Only 2 discounts may be applied per camper)

In order to get the **“Early Bird Discount”** of \$50 per session, Holmes must receive your **full fees by May 1, 2012** or at **Open House on May 20, 2012.**

In order to get the **“Bring a Friend Discount”**, register with a friend who has never attended Holmes Presbyterian Camp and Conference Center before, subtract **\$25** from your camp fee. **Both campers’ registration forms and deposits need to be in the same envelope for us to register them together and process the discount.**

In order to get the **“Sibling Discount”**, register your family members at the same time on separate forms. Subtract **\$25** from each additional camper fee. **Campers’ registration forms and deposits need to be in the same envelope for us to register them together and process the discount.**

In order to get the **“Multiple Week Discount”**, register for more than one camp session at one time. Subtract **\$25** from your camp fee for each session after the first.

How do I register for Adult and Family Programs?

If you are an adult (over age 21) registering, answer only the appropriate questions on the registration form. For You and Me, Grandparent/Grandchild, and Family Camp, list all minor registrants with age and gender on the registration form.

What if I need to cancel?

A refund of **all but the \$75 non-refundable deposit** will be returned to you if a **cancellation is made at least 2 weeks before** the session begins. After this, there are no refunds. If a camper is sent home sick, your fee will not be returned, but the camper may return at a later time if there is space available.
