#### **Playlist Prayer**

**SUPPLIES:** paper, writing utensil, \*music player *optional*

**INTRODUCTION:** Celebrating is a great way to worship and show God you are grateful for each day and all the things that you have to be thankful for. Singing, dancing, making music and listening to your favorite songs are all wonderful ways to share your joy with God.

**DIRECTIONS:** (1) Think about your favorite songs. What songs make you happy and want to dance? (2) Create a list of those songs. (3) Play or sing those songs and have a dance party to celebrate and thank God for another beautiful day.

**SUPPLIES:** paper, coloring utensils, scissors, glue/tape, other supplies\* (see directions)

**INTRODUCTION:** Everyday is beautiful in it's own way, the warm summer sun, a giggly raindrop dancing down the window or the strong wind making the trees dance and sway. The Earth is God's beautiful creation and we should celebrate each day that we have to enjoy the beauty around us. Decorate a space inside or outside and make it even more beautiful.

**DIRECTIONS:** (1) Use paper or other supplies to decorate a space in your house or yard. (2) Write jokes, draw pictures of happy memories, or draw pictures of beautiful things. (3) Hang up all of the tings you have made so other people can enjoy the beauty.

**OR** Have an ADULT help you plant a garden, or clean up trash in your neighborhood.

**SUPPLIES:** paper, pencil, coloring utensils (optional)

**INTRODUCTION:** Making other people smile is so much fun and is a good way to show them that you love them. Telling people how much they mean to you is a great way to make them smile and feel happy. Create cards for your loved ones to show them how much you love them.

**DIRECTIONS:** (1) Folding a piece of paper in half place your thumb and pointer finger along the folded edge. (2) trace your hand, keeping your thumb and pointer finger along the the folded edge. (3) With the paper still folded cut out your hand print, avoiding the point where the thumb and pointer fingers connect the front and back of the card. (4) Decorate the inside of the card with kind words, pictures, jokes and other beautiful things you wish to add.
