The park design was created in 1857 by landscape architects Frederick Law Olmsted and Calvert Vaux and the present day design was completed in 1876. Among its many attractions are Wollman Rink, Central Park Carousel, and the Central Park Zoo; Recreational activities include carriage-horse and

16 GETTYSBURG BATTLEFIELD GUIDED TOUR

6 HOUR TOUR WITH JOHN ECK, RETIRED HISTORY PROFESSOR; 1-5 PARTICIPANTS

The Battle of Gettysburg (July 1-3, 1863) was a turning point in the Civil War. This Union victory ended General Robert E. Lee's second and most ambitious invasion of the North and within 2 years the War would come to an end.



Join John in a guided walk into this profound American moment. Become acquainted with the battlefield leaders, learn about the trials of ordinary soldiers, and gain an in-depth understanding of that quintessential Lincoln moment... the Gettysburg Address. The hallowed Gettysburg battlefield is a fascinating place in terms of topography, national memory, heroism and pathos.

Tour will take place from about 10 am - 4 pm with a break for lunch. There will be approximately 2 miles of walking but John will tailor the tour in advance taking into account the interests and physical needs of the participants (and there will be an advance reading assignment!)

Just as the battle marked a turning point in the Civil War, so did a visit to the battlefield at age 10 mark one for John. From that moment on he read everything he could on the battle and then the war. Of particular interest in recent years has been the life and significance of Abraham Lincoln in our history. Taken together the events at Gettysburg and the pivotal role of Lincoln in the crisis of that moment are a remarkable story to be told. John's passion

for history has always been rooted in place. He continues to visit the sites and terrain of the past as a foundation for historical understanding. Ultimately, it was that day on the Gettysburg Battlefield that was the springboard for a career in teaching and a lifelong passion for history.

John recently retired from a forty-year teaching career where he taught at the middle-school, high school and community college level. His teaching journey included the Peace Corps in Chad, the UN School in NYC a therapeutic boarding school in Montana and many other places in between.


