We are close enough to New York City that we will take one day to see the play Dear Evan Hansen on Broadway, and see Stonewall Inn, where the modern LGBTQ+ movement is considered by many to have begun. Our time will focus around understanding, exploring, and feeding our spiritual selves and we'll do so from the various lenses of LGBTQ experience. You will leave with lifelong friends, a deep appreciation for the power and support of being in an LGBTQ+ community, and of course a sense of pride and gratitude for being who you are meant to be.
